Please give the completed application(s) to the CHS registrar, for processing. Once awarded, scholarships will be claimed by using the CHS scholarship retrieval form. Scholarship funds are held in trust by CSF until claimed and sent directly to the recipient's school, licensing or training.

Allen-Phipps Scholarships \$1000 (1-4 scholarships)

Students interested in medical, health, forestry, agriculture, or aquaculture may apply. Please apply using the CHS universal application.

Scholarships can be used for college or technical school.

bayleaf Foreign Study/Travel Scholarship - \$1000 (1 scholarship)

Any student who has been accepted, or intends to attend, an accredited university or college in the United States may apply. Students should indicate their intent to study/travel abroad during their tenure at university or college by way of the school's foreign studies programs in their educational goals statement. **This scholarship, once awarded, will be available for use until 2029. The scholarship will be held in trust by the Coupeville School Foundation. Once the student has been accepted into a study abroad/foreign studies program they can retrieve their scholarship. The funds may be used for tuition, student fees, and /or travel expenses associated with their school's foreign study program ONLY. Recipient must indicate on the retrieval form where the foreign study will be and the duration before the funds will be released. Funds will be retrieved using the form received at high school graduation.**

If the scholarship is not claimed within the allotted time a second scholarship will be offered the following year.
